

Mayfield Town Council Meeting

February 8, 2017

Regular meeting of the Mayfield Town Council was held on February 8, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the Mayfield Town Hall, located at 52 North Main Street, Mayfield, Utah.

Mayor John Christensen called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone to council meeting.

Pledge of Allegiance was offered.

Prayer was given by John Christensen.

Doug Bjerregaard from the Mayfield Lions Club was present to talk to the council about projects they are working on for the park for the upcoming summer. They are going to purchase new playground equipment, and are going to put in several pieces of exercise equipment for the park. He stated that they have about \$30,000.00 to put toward the projects.

Garrick Willden, our Engineer from Jones and Demille was present to talk to the council about the \$14,000.00 remaining from our road project. Garrick stated that at the entrance to the Mayfield Estates there is a drainage problem and we need to put in a catch station and a culvert to solve the problem. He is going to also contact The State Road Department to see if they will help with the cost etc. because of it is on the state highway. Garrick said that over by Andy Peterson we have the same problem and we will need to put in a catch basin there also. He said that he had talked to Van about the sprayer and will get a cost estimate for that and then the rest of the money will be used for gravel at the cemetery.

Mayor Christensen stated that he had talked to Shannon Ellsworth from Rural Community to set up a meeting to get started on our General Plan. They talked about having the meeting on February 22, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at the town hall. Catherine said she would post the notice for

the meeting and notify the members of the Planning Commission.

Mayor Christensen talked to the council about a grant that the Six County of Government has received to help low income people that are in crises and need help with utility bills etc.

Minutes for the regular meeting for the month of January were read. After some discussion motion was made by Eric to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by Zara, motion carried.

Bills were presented for payment of the month of February. After reviewing the bills motion was made by Zara to pay the bills including the power bill and Questar gas. Seconded by Eric, motion carried.

Catherine said that the Mayfield Town annual town clean-up will be the week of May 8th through May 11th. White's Sanitation will have a large dumpster at the park and they will dump it once during the week without additional charge.

Catherine stated that Ken Davis had contacted her concerning getting a building permit to start to do some remodeling on the old care center. After some discussion Malynda said to have Mr. Davis contact her.

Zara talked to the council about several of her concerns with the cemetery records. Zara went over what she would like to start on in the spring. She also said that she does not want Van to order sod for the graves this summer she will be planting grass.

The council talked about the cemetery roads. Mayor Christensen asked Zara to get a cost estimate of what it would cost to pave the cemetery roads.

The council discussed getting a volunteer program set-up and going in Mayfield.
