

# Mayfield Town Council Meeting

## February 10, 2016

---

Regular meeting of the Mayfield Town Council was held on February 10, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Mayfield Town Hall, located at 52 North Main Street, Mayfield, Utah.

Mayor John Christensen called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone to council meeting. Pledge of Allegiance was given and prayer was offered by Garrick Willden.

Garrick Willden our Engineer from Jones and Demille was present at the meeting to update the council on our road project and to review the financial report for the project with the council. He stated that we have a balance of \$45,073.36, and that includes the \$6,000.00 from the Utah Department of Transportation grant for a new sidewalk that we received. Garrick said that he approached the CIB to see if they would approve us putting a sidewalk from the Christenburg Road to the Mayfield Estates entrance, Mike Madsen had give him a bid for approximately \$32,000.00 which is 4,500.00 less than what Garrick budgeted. Mike will start sometime in May. We would have about \$6,000.00 remaining and Zara would like to see that go towards graveling the cemetery roads and parking area.

Garrick also presented a bill for his engineering fees in the amount of \$6,959.25.

David asked if we had talked to the people that are parking there heavy diesel trucks on our side roads. The council discussed several options to help with this problem.

David Haight was at the meeting to see where the council is on having police protection for this summer. Mr. Haight is concerned about the motorcycles and 4 wheelers speeding on the road by his home. After some discussion the council encouraged him to call the sheriff's office when this is happening because they are our law enforcement. The Mayor asked Mr. Haight to stay in touch with the council and to come back to meeting in a couple of months.

Minutes were read for the month of January 2016. After some discussion motion was made by Eric to accept the minutes with corrections. Seconded by Aaron, motion carried.

Bills were presented for payment for the month of February 2016. After reviewing the bills motion was made by Zara to pay the bills plus the power and Questar bills. Seconded by Eric, motion carried.

Catherine stated that Van would like to attend the Rural Water Conference. John stated that he would like to attend also. Catherine said she would get them registered and hotels for them for the conference.

Catherine said she had talked to White's Sanitation and she had set up our annual town clean-up for the week of May 9<sup>th</sup> thru May 16<sup>th</sup>.

Catherine reviewed with the council our budget report.

Zara talked to the council about Resolution 2015-16 B concerning spending of our Perpetual Care Fund Money. The council discussed changing the resolution to say that the money can only be spent on major projects and only up to 30% of the funds can be used.

Zara also updated the council on what she has planned for improvements up at the cemetery this coming spring.

Aaron Peterson stated that he had joined the Lions Club; he commented what an asset they have been to our community. He updated the council on some of the projects they talked about at their last meeting that they would like to do at the park. Aaron also discussed possibly putting in a hiking trail starting at the Mill Hill and having information plaques along the trail about Mayfield.

Mayor Christensen discussed with the council the areas that they would like to be over. After some discussion the Mayor made the following assignments:

John Christensen – Law Enforcement – Fire - Utilities
