

Mayfield Town Council Meeting

October 18, 2016

Regular meeting of the Mayfield Town Council was held on October 18, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Mayfield Town Hall, located at 52 North Main Street, Mayfield, Utah.

Mayor John Christensen called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone to council meeting.

Pledge of Allegiance was given by John P. Christensen

Prayer was given by Aaron Peterson

Mayor Christensen introduced Jed Hansen from the Gunnison Valley Fire Department. Mayor Christensen stated that he had invited him to council meeting to update the council on what they have been doing. Jed stated that the fire department has received a mini pumper truck for the fire department. He also talked to the council about the possibility of the Sanpete County Fire District taking over the Gunnison Valley Fire Station on a 99-year lease. Fire District would also assume the payment and cost of the building.

Zara asked Jed who was responsible for the care of and the upkeep on the fire hydrants in town. Jed stated that they are working on getting the equipment needed to test our hydrants. Jed also stated that the town is responsible to paint and clean the area around them. Garrick Willden stated that we need to keep a record of the flow on our fire hydrants for our future growth.

Mayor Christensen stated that he has been elected chairman of the Sanpete County Fire Board.

Aaron asked Jed if the fire department could do a fire safety training for the children in town in the summer. Jed said he would love to do that and will work on getting that setup.

Garrick Willden stated that his scouts were present as the meeting working on a community merit badge.

Minutes for the regular meeting for the months of August and September and the minutes for our September public hearing were read. After some discussion motion was made by Aaron to accept the minutes. Seconded by Malynda, motion carried.

Bills were presented for payment for the month of October. After reviewing the bills motion was made by Malynda to pay the bills. Seconded by Zara, motion carried.

The council discussed the Christmas candy for this year. After some discussion the council asked Catherine to order the same items as last year.

Mayor Christensen asked Malynda to attend a meeting on Tuesday the 25th of October in Manti at the courthouse. The meeting is concerning the County Zoning and issues with the buffer zone.

Malynda stated that the meeting with CIB concerning our application for a grant for our General Plan will be held in Moab on November 3rd, at 8:30. Mayor Christensen said that he would be going to the meeting.

Malynda presented a new business license application for the town. She also talked to the council about adding an application fee of \$25.00 plus the business license fee which is; Home license - \$50.00. Commercial \$50.00, per-day license \$20.00. Class A beer license fee \$25.00, Class B Beer License fee \$50.00 and a Class C Beer License After reviewing the new application and fees motion was made by Aaron to approve the new business license application and fees. Also, that they would take affect immediately. Seconded by Zara, motion carried.

Zara updated the council on the cemetery projects. She stated that she would like to close the cemetery at night and she will be responsibly to lock it at night.

Mayor Christensen talked about a new app called “alert Sense”

The Mayor also asked if someone else would like to take over being Santa’s helper for this year. There was no response.
