

Mayfield Town Council Meeting

August 8, 2016

Regular meeting of the Mayfield Town Council was held on August 8 at 7:00 p.m. at the Mayfield Town Hall, located at 52 North Main Street, Mayfield, Utah.

Mayor John Christensen called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone to council meeting.

Pledge of Allegiance was offered.

Prayer was given by Mayor John Christensen.

Garrick Willden our Engineer was present at the meeting to present a final payment voucher for the sidewalk project at the Mayfield Estates. He stated that the total cost was \$34,000.00 for the project. He said that there is \$14,046.26 remaining of the grant money. The council discussed purchasing a sprayer for Van to spray the roads with the remaining money or possibly installing a culvert at the entrance of the Mayfield Estates to help with drainage.

Mayor Christensen introduced the Police Chiefs from Gunnison and Centerfield. He stated that he had invited them to answer questions and to talk to the council about possibly signing an inter-local agreement with them for police protection in Mayfield. After much discussion the council thanked them for coming and they were excused.

Mayor Christensen updated the council on the fire burning up the canyon by the Town Cabin. He also stated that the Forest Service had rebuilt the road up to the cabin for the firefighters.

Mark Hopkins, our Town Dog Catcher was present at the meeting to update the council about any problems or concerns he had in town. Mark discussed issues he has had with cats in town and one potbelly pig. The council thanked Mark for the job he does. Mark was excused.

Catherine went over items in the council packets. The Sanpete County Fair board has sent a letter asking the town to participate in the Car Show again this year. The cost is \$35.00 for the town and we will need to have someone there from Mayfield to award our pick. The council asked Catherine to take care of this.

Minutes were read for the month of July, after some discussion motion was made by Malynda to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by Eric, motion carried.

Bills for the month of August were presented for payment. After reviewing the bills motion was made by Eric to accept the bills, seconded by Malynda

Malynda went over the town survey results with the council. She stated that she would like to lift the moratorium on business licenses in town, but would like to put a moratorium on conditional use permits until our General Plan is in place.

Malynda talked with the council about our business licenses in town and changes she would like to see made. Malynda made the motion to have the council give Mayfield Town Planning Commission control over approving and issuing business licenses in town. Seconded by Eric, motion carried. She is also in the process of updating our business license application.

The council discussed setting up a time to hold a public hearing to talk about moving forward with updating our General Plan. We need to have a Public hearing before we can apply for a grant with CIB grant. We also need to have a public hearing to discuss Mayfield Town signing an Inter-local Agreement with Centerfield and Gunnison Police Department for Police Protection in Mayfield. After some discussion motion was made by Eric to have a Public Hearing on August 31, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. seconded by Malynda. Motion carried.
