

Mayfield Town Council Meeting

October 10, 2018 (Recording #69-70)

Regular meeting of the Mayfield Town Council was held on October 10, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. at the Mayfield Town Hall, located at 52 North Main Street, Mayfield, Utah.

Mayor Christensen welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Minutes for the month of September 2018 were presented to the council. After some discussion motion was made by Mike to accept the minutes, seconded by Aaron. (Roll Call Vote - John - Yes, Mike - Yes, - Aaron - Yes,).

Bills were presented for payment for the month of October 2018. After reviewing the bills motion was made by Aaron to pay the bills. Seconded by Mike motion carried. (Roll Call vote Mike - Yes, John - Yes, Aaron - Yes,).

The GVHS Girls Basketball team had sent a letter asking for support for there banner fundraiser for \$125.00. Motion was made by Aaron to support the team, seconded by Mike. Motion carried.

Catherine stated that the county Assessor had called and was concerned that we had allowed Mr. Mallory to build his home on two separate lots of his and would like the Town to not allow it any longer and require the land owner to have the land surveyed into one lot.

John talked to the council about a workshop with Utah Outdoor Recreation Grant that will be held on Tuesday, October 16, 2018 in Richfield. The Utah Outdoor Recreation Grant provides matching grant funding to local governments and nonprofits to build outdoor recreation infrastructure such as trails, boat ramps etc. Aaron said he would attend the workshop.

Mayor Christensen stated that a letter has been sent to the owner of the care center to have him secure the property. The council talked about different options that the property could be used for if the town purchased the property. Mike talked about a fire station on the lot. He stated we need to have something there that would improve the center of town.

Mayor updated the council on the new water project.

Mike said that he has talked to Doug Willden about the back wall of the Town Cabin. He feels that railroad ties would work good and last for a long time. The Mayor asked Mike to talk to Eldon Olson also about his plans to repair the back wall.

Aaron said he has been checking on the cemetery. Aaron stated that he would like to get in touch with the company that put in the new sprinkler system last year and have them put in the line that still needs to be completed. Catherine said she would talk to Van and to the company that installed the system last summer.

Aaron also discussed the trees that are not doing well at the cemetery he said that those trees are not good for this area and we will need to replace them.

Aaron updated the council on the grant he was working on for a social worker for this area. He did receive the grant and is working on filling the position. Part of the job will be to find children that are preschool age and not in school and are in the inter-poverty group.

John asked the council to think about who would be willing to be a Santa helper for Christmas Eve.
