Council Member Aaron Peterson welcomed everyone to the meeting.

James Willden was present at the meeting to present to the council what he would like to do for his Eagle project. James stated that he wanted to fix the back wall of the Town Cabin. He said that he wanted to use railroad ties to rebuild the wall. The council discussed different ideas for materials to use to repair the wall. After some discussion a motion was made by Aaron to cover the cost of the project and have James move forward with his project. seconded by Mike.

Malynda talked about our ordinances we have in place and stated that we have just completed our General Fund and will now start to enforce our current ordinances. Bills were presented for payment for the month of July 2019. After reviewing the bills motion was made by Malynda to pay the bills, seconded by Mike, motion carried. (Roll Call vote - Mike - yes, Aaron - yes, Malynda - yes).

Catherine talked about concerns she had about young adults going into the care center. Cathy Conally has seen them going into the back door at night. Malynda said to have Cathy call the sheriff's office and then they will contact the owner.

The council discussed the town maintenance job and if there is a need to make it a full time position. Also, if the town can afford to pay for a full time position.

Malynda talked to the council about giving the Mayor and Council a pay increase to \$300.00 for the mayor and \$100.00 a month for the council members. She stated that we need to inform the Mayfield residents that with this raise the mayor and council would make \$25.00 a meeting and then the council would be expected to put in 3 more hours of service and the mayor would need to show that he has also completed his hours. Then when we have a new council or mayor they would have an idea of what they have signed up for.

The council talked about having the employees do a time study for two weeks. Catherine said she would get that going.

Garrick Willden was at the meeting to update the council on the new water project. He stated they are waiting on some paperwork that still needs to be completed and then they will bid out the project.

Aaron discussed the cemetery and how dry it is.
