Catherine stated that our Annual Drinking Water Quality Report is complete for 2016. She will inform the Town Residents in next month's newsletter.

She would like to have everything in place and report to the town on what has been found and then aim for September 1st to send out the survey to the town residents. She also talked about the need to have someone that would be willing to go over the survey to proof the grammar, history of the town etc. The council talked about Doug Bjerregaard, Dale Harwood, and Mayor Christensen.

Malynda updated the council on the Planning Commission Meeting that was held last week. Mr. and Mrs. Davis is interested in putting in a store in the old care center. She said they are working

on their permits that are needed to get a license. Malynda said that once they have them in place the commission voted to issue them a business license.

Zara updated the council on the new sprinkler system project at the cemetery. She also talked about the items she would like to finish before the end of summer.

John stated that he had gone with a representative from our insurance company, Utah Local Governments Trust. He did a survey all of the properties that we have insured with them. John stated that he is also coming back next Friday to go up to the town cabin.

John told the council that he has rented Eldon Olsen and his tractor to finish mowing the streets that did not get completed. John also stated that Tyler is going to clear the weeds around all of our fire hydrants this week.

John said that the Lions Club has contacted the town about applying again for another \$25,000.00 grant from the Eccles Foundation to help with completing several projects they would like to do at the park.

Maylnda talked about different ways to get more town residents involved in town and with the Lions.
