

Mayfield Town Council Meeting November 9, 2016

Regular meeting of the Mayfield Town Council was held on November 9, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Mayfield Town Hall, located at 52 North Main Street, Mayfield, Utah.

Mayor John Christensen called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone to council meeting.

Pledge of Allegiance was given by John P. Christensen

Prayer was given by Zara Faatz

Mayor Christensen stated that Harvey and Patti Sorensen are the agenda because they would like to have a stop sign on the corner by their property. Eric said that he would stop and talk to them to see what their concerns are.

Mike Bennett, a representative for the Sanpete County Fair board was at the meeting to see if the council had decided if they were going to donate to the county fairgrounds project. Mayor Christensen stated that we had received \$475.00 from Mayfield residents for the project. The council discussed what they would like to also donate to the project. After some discussion motion was made by Eric to give \$1,500.00 to Mr. Bennett toward the project. Seconded by Zara, motion carried.

Minutes for the regular meeting for the month of and the minutes for our October meeting were read. After reviewing the minutes motion was made by Zara to accept the minutes with correction. Seconded by Eric, motion carried.

Bills were presented for payment for the month of November. After reviewing the bills motion was made by Zara to pay the bills. Seconded by Eric, motion carried.

Malynda updated the council on what she had found out concerning a meeting about conflict the county is having with the buffer zones in different communities within the county. Grant Hansen our Zoning Administrator explained to the council our current buffer zone.

Malynda also stated that we have received a CIB grant for \$15,000.00 to move forward with our General Plan. It is a matching grant so the town will need to pay the additional \$15,000.00 to cover the cost of \$30,000.00 to complete our General Plan. She said that we are working on redoing our Planning Commission Committee and will be working on the project in February.

Zara discussed several concerns up at the cemetery. She stated that Mike Madsen is going to cleanup, level and put rock on the south side of the cemetery. She said that the water in the sprinkling system has been drained. She also went over the projects that have been completed and the things she would still like to see done including history markers.

Zara talked to the council about all the great people that have donated to the cemetery project and how much she appreciates their time, money, labor etc. to help with all that has been done at the cemetery.

Zara stated that she had read the town audit report that had been completed by Kimball and Roberts and went over several questions she had about posting the minutes, agendas, financial statements to our website and the public website.

The council discussed Patti Sorensen's concern about needing a stop sign or yield sign over on the corner by her home. After some discussion Eric made the motion to put in a yield sign on the corner facing west by the Sorenson home. Seconded by Zara, motion carried.

John said that he had attended the CDBG Grant Application training meeting. He went over a few things that we would need to have in place to apply for a grant.

John also stated that Sanpete County has put in a Radio Repeater up at the booster station. They hope that it will help with radio traffic up 12 miles.
