Regular meeting of the Mayfield Town Council was held on December 12, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at the Mayfield Town Hall, located at 52 North Main Street, Mayfield, Utah.

Mayor Christensen welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Minutes for the month of November 2018 were presented to the council. After some discussion motion was made by Mike to accept the minutes, seconded by Eric. (Roll Call Vote - John - yes, Eric - yes, - Aaron - yes, Mike - yes).

Bills were presented for payment for the month of December 2018. Catherine said that the \$400.00 check made out to John was a donation from the Mayfield Town Lions that they would like it cashed and donated to the Mayfield Ward Bishop for Sub for Santa. After reviewing the bills motion was made by Eric to pay the bills including the power bill. Seconded by John, motion carried. (Roll Call vote Eric - yes, John - yes, Aaron - yes, Mike - yes).

300 feet of his property. After reviewing the annexation motion was made by Aaron to accept the annexation, seconded by Eric. Motion carried.

Mayor Christensen said that he has an idea for Eagle Projects. To replace or paint the Mayfield Post Office flag pole and install a light so it can stay up all the time.

The council discussed sending Claudia Jarrett a card expressing their appreciation for her wonderful service over the years in so many areas of the county.

The council discussed the need to look at our zoning ordinance and make changes to two family dwellings.

They also discussed how to handle our ordinance enforcement concerns. Eric suggested we talk to other communities to see if they have found a solution to this problem.

The council discussed different ideas that they could have on the property we own up by the White Hills. The council talked about a gun range, archery course etc.

Aaron stated that the county is developing a leadership council called "Communities that care". He said that there are youtube videos that you can watch to help better understand the program. It is a new program to help get services to people in our communities that need help and are not receiving them or don't know about them.

John updated the council on what he has been learning on the Utah League of Cities and Towns committee and also the legislative policy committee.
